Just as Marion Cotillard was to *La Vie en Rose*, Golden Globe-nominated actor Tahar Rahim is to *MONSIEUR AZNAVOUR*, transforming into the iconic singer/songwriter for this lavishly entertaining rise-to-stardom biography of the man who beat all odds to not only become one of France's best-loved entertainers, but personified French culture to the rest of the world.

Born in Paris in 1924 as the son of Armenian refugees, Charles Aznavour's formative years are spent in poverty, but distinguished by his parents' passion for music and theatre. Ridiculed for his short stature and raspy tenor voice – traits he would in time fully embrace – Aznavour's early attempts at a showbiz career during the Occupation falter.


Whilst gifted, his material finds more success in the hands of others, including his friend Pierre (Bastien Bouillon), and later the imperious Edith Piaf (a scene-stealing Marie-Julie Baup), who becomes a highly influential mentor and supporter. But by the 1950s, Aznavour finally realises his own ambitions; his empathetic 'chansons' about the heartbreaks, confusions and passions of the common man (mining the dramas of his own life) catapult him to global attention.

Led by its star's astonishing performance and stunning vocal provess, MONSIEUR AZNAVOUR is a true tour de force – as intimate as it is spectacular – and serves as a triumphant reminder of the power and impact of music.

Sarah Bernhardt (Sandrine Kiberlain, November, AF FFF23) is larger than life and a cyclone of contradictions. The original theatre diva, her world is blinding stage lights, opulent wealth, and delicious scandals. Ruled by fleeting fancies and sweeping emotions, she even holds court from her sickbed. And what better time to revisit her groundbreaking 19th-century stardom than in recovery from surgery?

Guillaume Nicloux's decadent biopic is an experience like no other: from exotic menageries to consuming affairs, La Divine is as showstopping as she is capricious. Patron to Alphonse Mucha, friend to Victor Hugo, and "little star" to Alexandre Dumas, Sarah Bernhardt defied societal expectations, adored dramatic death scenes and scandalised her convent with a lizard's funeral. Nicloux's film vividly recounts Bernhardt's tempestuous story and is a dazzling chronicle of a chameleonic actress who defined her generation.

In the tradition of on-the-road dramatic comedies like Little Miss Sunshine, *MEET THE LEROYS* is the moving story of the veneer we paint over lost connections and a reminder that even the brightest bonds, like stars, can fade, despite our best intentions.

Sandrine Leroy (Charlotte Gainsbourg, My Dog Stupid, AF FFF20) is bitterly unhappy. When she announces her intention to divorce her husband, Christophe (José Garcia), he is left reeling. With Sandrine set on separation and their children feigning ambivalence, Christophe has only one thing left up his sleeve: a surprise, nostalgic road trip weekend with the entire family. The deal? If Sandrine doesn't change her mind by the end of the trip, he'll let her go. But is one weekend enough to overcome years of stale marriage? And how can they rekindle the passion that once consumed them?

Directed by Florent Bernard, MEET THE LEROYS won the Grand Prix at the Alpe d'Huez Film Festival for its sincere depiction of a family in crisis. Inspired by Bernard's own experience of his parents' divorce and shot in Burgundy where he grew up, the film is a bittersweet exploration of the things we lose without realising.

A sensation at Cannes and one of France's biggest box office and audience favourites of the year (achieving over two million admissions and entry into the top five of 2024), writer/ director Emmanuel Courcol's wildly entertaining new film follows two very different siblings separated by fate and reunited by their love of music.

Thibaut (the exceptional Benjamin Lavernhe, Delicious, C'est la vie!) is a beloved and internationally celebrated orchestra conductor who travels the globe. When a health crisis and subsequent DNA test inadvertently reveal he was adopted as an infant. Thibaut discovers the existence of a younger brother, Jimmy (rising star Pierre Lottin), who lives in more modest circumstances: he works in a school cafeteria. cares for his mother and plays the trombone in a community brass band. The pair seem to have little else in common other than a love of performance, but sensing his sibling's exceptional talent, Thibaut decides to remedy the injustice of fate and try to help nurture his brother's untapped gifts.

An eruptive crowd favourite wherever it has premiered (notably receiving the highest audience score in the 51-year history of the San Sebastian Film Festival), MY BROTHER'S BAND is a rousing, feel-great trip to the cinema, expertly striking the perfect harmony between laughter and tears. The remarkable Mélanie Laurent and Guillaume Canet take centre stage in writer- director Gianluca Jodice's transfixing historical drama, evocatively depicting the last days of the French Revolution and the fates of Marie Antoinette and King Louis XVI.

1792. The official Parisian residence of the king, the Tuileries Palace, has been stormed. Louis, Marie Antoinette and their children have been arrested and confined in a medieval chateau in the city centre. Far from the splendour of Versailles, where the family and their retinue had lived until only a few years earlier, they are vulnerable for the first time in their lives. While the King naively tries to keep spirits high and manners intact, his pragmatic and imperious wife is far more realistic about their predicament, and the destiny that likely awaits them... Drawn from the diaries of Louis XVI's personal valet, this exceptionally crafted drama features not only marvellous production design and cinematography, but incredible costumes by twice Oscar-nominated designer Massimo Cantini Parrini. Dominated by the outstanding performances of its two leads, *THE DELUGE* is a compelling dramatic rejoinder to Sofia Coppola's *Marie Antoinette* and Benoît Jacquot's *Farewell My Queen*, which both depicted the royal couple's lives well before the party was over.

Retired French general François (André Dussollier, Everything Went Fine, AF FFF22) and his wife Annie (Sabine Azéma) have been married for five decades. Enjoying all the perks of retirement, François heads to the attic one day to declutter old boxes and dust off memories, only to stumble upon his worst nightmare: a stack of love letters revealing his wife's affair from forty years ago.

It's up to François to make the mature choice: does he turn the other cheek and let bygones be bygones? Or does he sharpen his wits and call in favours to track down the man who humiliated him? Hell-bent on the latter, François scours the Côte-d'Azur, determined to exact revenge – even if it means losing what he holds most dear in the process. It's time for vengeance, French Riviera-style!

This delightfully contagious comedy from director Ivan Calbéra (*The Tasting*, AF FFF23), proves you're never too old for crazy acts of love – or payback. With stunning backdrops, a whole lot of heart and shenanigans a-plenty, *RIVIERA REVENGE* is guaranteed to make you both laugh and cry. No one ever said marriage was easy and who could resist retribution by the seaside?

No one gets past her eagle eye, not even Victor (Édouard Baer, *How to Be a Good Wife*, AF FFF20), a charming but down-on-his-luck French chef from New York, who finds his knives and gourmet food unfairly confiscated.

Meanwhile, Sonia's daughter Lili-Beth is sick of being bullied at school. When she enters a Mini Chefs competition to stick it to her bullies, it seems she's the underdog with no hope of winning. Unless Julie can convince Victor to help her.

However, it's not just the pressure of the Mini Chefs competition that threatens to boil over: community tensions and divisions are bubbling under the surface of this rural border town, with bitterness an all-too-familiar flavour. But Sonia, Victor and Lili-Beth are about to serve up something new.

This feast of a comedy from director Manon Briand is full of laughs and touching connections. Set in the beautiful Canadian countryside and replete with mouthwatering dishes, *ALL STIRRED UPI* is a deliciously heartwarning story that will leave you hungry for more.

The phenomenal Adèle Exarchopoulos and François Civil – arguably French cinema's brightest young talents – devour the screen in Gilles Lellouche's vibrant, genre-spanning romantic epic that follows a written-in-the-stars infatuation tested by social boundaries, betrayal and circumstances beyond all control.

Love makes one crazy. Just ask Clotaire (Civil) and Jackie (Exarchopoulos), who meet in their teens in their Northern France working-class neighbourhood in the 1980s. Despite their differences – she is a diligent student from the middle class, he a charming troublemaker with a complex family life – an intense and unmistakable connection is sparked. But tragedy soon pulls them apart.

A decade later, Clotaire tries desperately to win back his lost love. Has his chance passed?

Driven by a kinetic soundtrack, indelible production design and all-star supporting cast, *BEATING HEARTS* pays homage to the US independent film wave of the 1980s and early 1990s but creates an impact truly of its own. Delivering another massive, crowd-pleasing blockbuster result at the French box office (after *Sink Or Swim*) with an extraordinary five million admissions, Lellouche reaches for the stars and rewards all who strap in for the ride.

Penny-pinching Justine (Sandrine Kiberlain, November, AF FFF23) is sick of hustling. So when her boss, high-flying investor Franck (Daniel Auteuil, A Silence, AF FFF24), approaches her to organise a showstopping romantic weekend for him and the woman with whom he has fallen hopelessly in love, she jumps on board. What could possibly go wrong with €14,000 cash upfront and a weekend of romance?

Given free creative control, Justine and her unemployed husband Albin (Denis Podalydès, *The President's Wife*, AF FFF24) devise the perfect solution: they'll give Franck their own profit-making version of the ultimate love boat experience. Engaging a motley crew of friends also keen to make a buck, they're like *Ocean's Eleven* on a budget. But when Franck reveals that Justine is the woman of his dreams, it looks like this love boat is about to get a little crowded...

LOVE BOAT is a hysterical comedy of errors from actor-director Bruno Podalydès that will have you laughing out loud at absurd disguises, misguided intentions, and chaotic schemes. Expect the very best of the worst – half bottles, cut corners, and special deals – all as long as it's not too expensive.

Agathe (Camille Rutherford) lives the rom-com dream: she works in the famous Shakespeare & Co bilingual bookstore where customers leave love letters on the mirror quoting Tolstoy, and there's undeniable chemistry with her colleague, Félix (Pablo Pauly, *Murder Party*, AF FFF24). Beneath the glossy *Notting Hill* facade, however, she's an unpublished romance author battling writer's block, living with her sister and nephew. More akin to *Persuasion's* Anne, a perpetual wallflower, than *Pride and Prejudice's* confident Elizabeth, Agathe struggles to find her voice.

That all changes when Agathe is invited to a Jane Austen Residency in England. Spending two weeks in a manor full of creative nooks and wandering through forests and glades, Agathe struggles daily with imposter syndrome. That is, until she starts to become acquainted with the handsome yet prickly Oliver Lowe (Charlie Anson, *Downton Abbey*), Jane Austen's living descendant. Grappling with her demons and her heart, Agathe must decide between what she's always known, and something – or someone – new.

This romantic comedy-drama from writer-director Laura Piani is a touching love letter to the Regency author who still shapes our conversations on love today. Wry, subtle, and with a big heart, JANE AUSTEN WRECKED MY LIFE asks, would you write the end to your own love story if you could?

Delivery workers have become an indispensable part of city life, especially since the pandemic. Premiering in the Un Certain Regard section at the Cannes Film Festival 2024, *THE KINGDOM* is a powerful debut film that is a richly sensory experience – a must-see drama embodied by fierce, tender love.

Corsica, 1995. Lesia (Ghjuvanna Benedetti) is desperate for a normal teenage life. However, amidst the island's gang politics, she's not just the daughter of notorious mafioso – she's a potential target. Taken from the beachside to an unknown villa, she is reunited with her father, Pierre-Paul (Saveriu Santucci), who is hiding from the police. As her summer holidays melt away, she is drawn deeper into his world of blood feuds and violent retribution. When all-out war erupts, Pierre-Paul and Lesia must go to ground, where they will face each other and themselves.

With unflinching realism, THE KINGDOM is a powerful account of family bonds and gang violence, told by Corsican first-time director Julien Colonna and a non-professional cast. A peek into a turbulent world as seen through the eyes of a child, Colonna's film never falls into caricature. Rather, it serves as a testament to the humanity found beneath the surface and the roles we are forced to play to survive.

HOLY COW / VINGT DIEUX

Direct from the Cannes Film Festival 2024, *HOLY COW* marks Louise Courvoisier as a powerful new voice in cinema, winning the festival's prestigious Youth Prize in the Un Certain Regard category.

In the Jura region, renowned for its Comté cheese, 18-year-old Totone (Clément Faveau) has his childhood cut short after a devastating tragedy. Suddenly the sole carer for his 7-year-old sister Claire (Luna Garret), and forced to sell his father's farm equipment to make ends meet, Totone devises a plan: follow in his family's cheesemaking footsteps and win the €30,000 Comté cheese prize – even though he has no idea of where to start.

With an unfiltered realism, this debut features heartfelt performances by non-professional actors and real farmers, bringing raw authenticity to Courvoisier's first feature film. Shot on location in the countryside of the director's childhood, and with her entire family contributing to the soundtrack and set design, *HOLY COW* is a beautiful ode to neorealist classics like *Bicycle Thieves* made fresh for modern audiences.

THE TIES THAT BIND US

A poignant adaptation of Alice Ferney's book *L'Intimité*, Carine Tardieu's film is a meditation on beliefs and convictions, as well as the transformation available to us when we pivot and grow.

Sandra (Valeria Bruni Tedeschi, Anaïs in Love, AF FFF22), a feminist librarian, is not interested in children. In addition to this ambivalence, she has vowed never to become a mother. When her neighbour Alex (Pio Marmaï, *The Three Musketeers - Part I & II*, AF FFF24) asks Sandra to watch his six-year-old son Elliot (César Botti) while his pregnant wife, Cécile, gives birth, Sandra sees it as just a one-off – until Cécile tragically dies after labour.

Caught between grief and a desire for connection, Sandra, Alex, and Elliot's lives become entangled in unforeseen ways, creating bonds and challenges as they wrestle with evolving definitions of love. Tender and never didactic, *THE TIES THAT BIND US* is a powerful reminder that it takes many shapes to form a family.

Expertly navigating unexpected connections and how they can subtly but profoundly shift our worldviews, Tardieu's masterful drama presents an empathetic, non-judgmental observation of all the ways we form attachments – and how love triumphs where we least expect it.

Guided by Masset's radical approach to patient care, Toussaint discovers the power of returning choice to the body and the dignity in dying as one chooses.

Dialogical and Socratic in tone, yet never stuffy, this film lyrically grapples with unanswerable questions, responding to our existential fears with love and care. In the spirit of groundbreaking philosophical films like *My Dinner with André*, Costa-Gavras deftly teaches without instructing. Daring to ask life's biggest questions, *BEFORE WHAT COMES AFTER* invites us to listen closely – the answers may surprise us.

WHEN FALL IS COMING

Direct from the San Sebastián International Film Festival, and winner of the Jury Prize for Best Screenplay, François Ozon's (Everything Went Fine, AF FFF21) haunting drama, WHEN FALL IS COMING, marks the director's return to his signature lyricism.

In the depths of autumn in Burgundy, Michelle (Hélène Vincent, *The Extraordinary*, AF FFF20) spends her quiet, isolated life foraging in the undergrowth for mushrooms with Marie-Claude. When Michelle's acerbic daughter, Valérie (Ludivine Sagnier, Of *Love and Lies*, AF FFF20), drops her son off for the school holidays, Michelle hopes his stay will rekindle their strangled relationship. But when Michelle makes a mistake, she risks everything and her relationship with everyone. Alienated from her daughter again and shadowed by guilt, Michelle's world turns bleak – until Marie-Claude's son (Pierre Lottin) is unexpectedly released from prison.

WHEN FALL IS COMING is an atmospheric film that maps our mistakes and our redemption, our second chances and changing seasons. Amidst the beauty of autumnal Burgundy, Ozon's film reveals a quietly menacing undercurrent. This darkness sets off a chain of startling events and highlights secrets, which like poisonous mushrooms, often lurk in plain sight.

1972: When 16-year-old aspiring actress Maria Schneider (Anamaria Vartolomei, *The Count of Monte Cristo*, AF FFF25) reconnects with the father and movie star who abandoned her as a child, she is kicked out of home.

Distanced from her mother's controlling influence, she is drawn into the orbit of aspiring director Bernardo Bertolucci (Giuseppe Maggio), and cast alongside superstar Marlon Brando (Matt Dillon) in the salacious *Last Tango in Paris*, Bertolucci's provocative new film inspired by his fantasies. However, this opportunity comes at a heavy cost. Despite only consenting to scripted nudity, Schneider is ambushed by an improvised scene of sexual assault devised by Bertolucci and Brando.

BEING MARIA is the powerful and damning exploration of the monstrous side of art, and the women left to pick up the pieces. In the wake of #MeToo, Palud poses a vital question: for women, is it ever truly just "show business"?

As pressure builds from Leslie's imposing older brother and her classmates, and the discomforting ramifications of the accusation - and the motivations behind it spread into the community at large, both Julien and Leslie face not only hostility, but danger...

Set within the microcosm of the school, but reflective of wider society, Lussi-Modeste's enthralling, nuanced and conversationstarting film is an intelligent and highly believable exploration of the complexities of human behaviour in the post #MeToo era.

BOLERO / BOLERO

Every 15 minutes, someone somewhere in the world plays Ravel's "Bolero" – it's a legacy its artist could never have imagined.

Renowned composer Maurice Ravel (Raphaëi Personnaz) is haunted by self-doubt and melancholy. Commissioned by eccentric and magnanimous Russian dancer Ida Rubenstein (César-winning Jeanne Balibar), he must compose a carnal, rapturous fanfare for her latest ballet. Blocked creatively and cast aside by his peers, Ravel turns to his closest friends for inspiration – pianist Marguerite Long (Emmanuelle Devos, *Mascarade*, AF FFF23), his friend Cipa (Vincent Perez) and Cipa's sister Misia (Doria Tillier), whom he hopelessly adores. Set against the decadent, industrialised Paris of the 1920s, "Bolero" demands that Ravel draw on the essence of sound itself to redeem his raw genius, or risk being consumed by it completely.

A tribute to the timelessness of the composer's haunting masterpiece, *Bolero*, writer-director Anne Fontaine takes us on a deconstructed, elliptical journey through the idiosyncratic life of Maurice Ravel, via his struggle to complete that 17-minute piece of music. Straight from the 2024 Festival du Cinéma Américain de Deauville and filmed on location in Mauritius, Simon Moutaïrou's powerful debut is an unmissable journey following those who dare to stand against injustice.

In 1759, Mauritius is a profitable colonial outpost for France, but for Massamba (Ibrahima Mbaye) and his daughter Mati (Anna Diakhere Thiandoum), it's a living hell. Slaves on a sugar plantation owned by the ruthless Eugène Larcenet (Benoît Magimel, *The Taste of Things*, AF FFF24), they are the victims of brutal laws enforced under the guise of justice – even though Larcenet's son Honoré (Félix Lefebvre) fiercely disagrees. In this world, disobedience means death. Yet Massamba remains blind to the growing resistance in Mati, whose salvation lies not in becoming a seamstress but in escape at any cost.

When Mati flees the plantation, Larcenet calls on the uncompromising maroon hunter, Madame La Victoire (Camille Cottin, *Call My Agent*), a devout Catholic and Royalist, to bring her back. Aided by her militant sons, Madame La Victoire will bring Mati before God and the law – unless Massamba can reach her first.

NO CHAINS NO MASTERS captures history with unflinching force – a festival experience for the big screen.

As buried memories and long-held secrets stir to the surface, Juliette must grapple with how to remain connected to the fractured family's story, and reclaim her own identity.

Based on a graphic novel by Camille Jourdy (whose work formed the basis for the equally-winning hit *Rosalie Blum*), Lenoir's gorgeous film finds pathos and humour in even the worst behaviours of her richly captured protagonists. *JULIETTE* is a gem to be treasured.

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


